General Class Overview

How Marriage 101 Works – Marriage 101 is a video led series that addresses a different aspect of marriage each week. After the video will be a time to discuss how to make practical application, and/or ask questions to learn from others' experiences of how to make our marriages what God intended them to be. This time is directed by a group discussion guide, but will also provide the freedom to have open discussion for those who wish to participate.

The Foundation For Healing – We believe God created marriage. Therefore, we believe He knows best how to make marriage successful. However, please know that we do not require you to be a Christian to attend the class. While we are certainly going to lean on the principles of marriage and healthy relationships spelled out in God's Word, our intent is not to "shove religion down your throat." Our intent is to help you have the best marriage.

The name of the video series and corresponding group discussion guide we are using is entitled, "Marriage on the Rock," by Jimmy Evans. Small Group Guidelines

Maintain Confidentiality – Don't talk about things you hear in the group to people outside the group. Being in this group is your commitment to confidentiality. This will help develop an atmosphere of trust. (NOTE: There is no way that the group can guarantee confidentiality, so use discretion about what you share.)

Sharing – There is no requirement that you talk in the group, but you are encouraged to do so! If you do share, please comment only on your situation.

Be Sensitive – Some of you are naturally outgoing and comfortable in sharing your feelings. Some of you are a bit quieter. If you are outgoing, make sure you do not dominate the group. If you tend to be quiet or shy, please make an effort to participate. (You will be glad you did!)

Time Constraints – Please understand that the reality of our society dictates that each session will have set times for beginning and ending. For some of you, this is a relief; for others, this will be a challenge. It is our intention to provide an environment where everyone has the opportunity to share as they have need. However, there may be weeks where not everyone will get to share. As facilitators, we will do our best to accommodate everyone.

Professional Counseling – We are facilitators of a video series. We are not professional counselors, and we do not attempt to be. We are here to show the love and grace of God and to teach the practical application of Godly principles for marriage. If you and your spouse have a need for professional counseling, we will be glad to provide you a list of names of counselors in the area who have a reputation of doing quality counseling.
